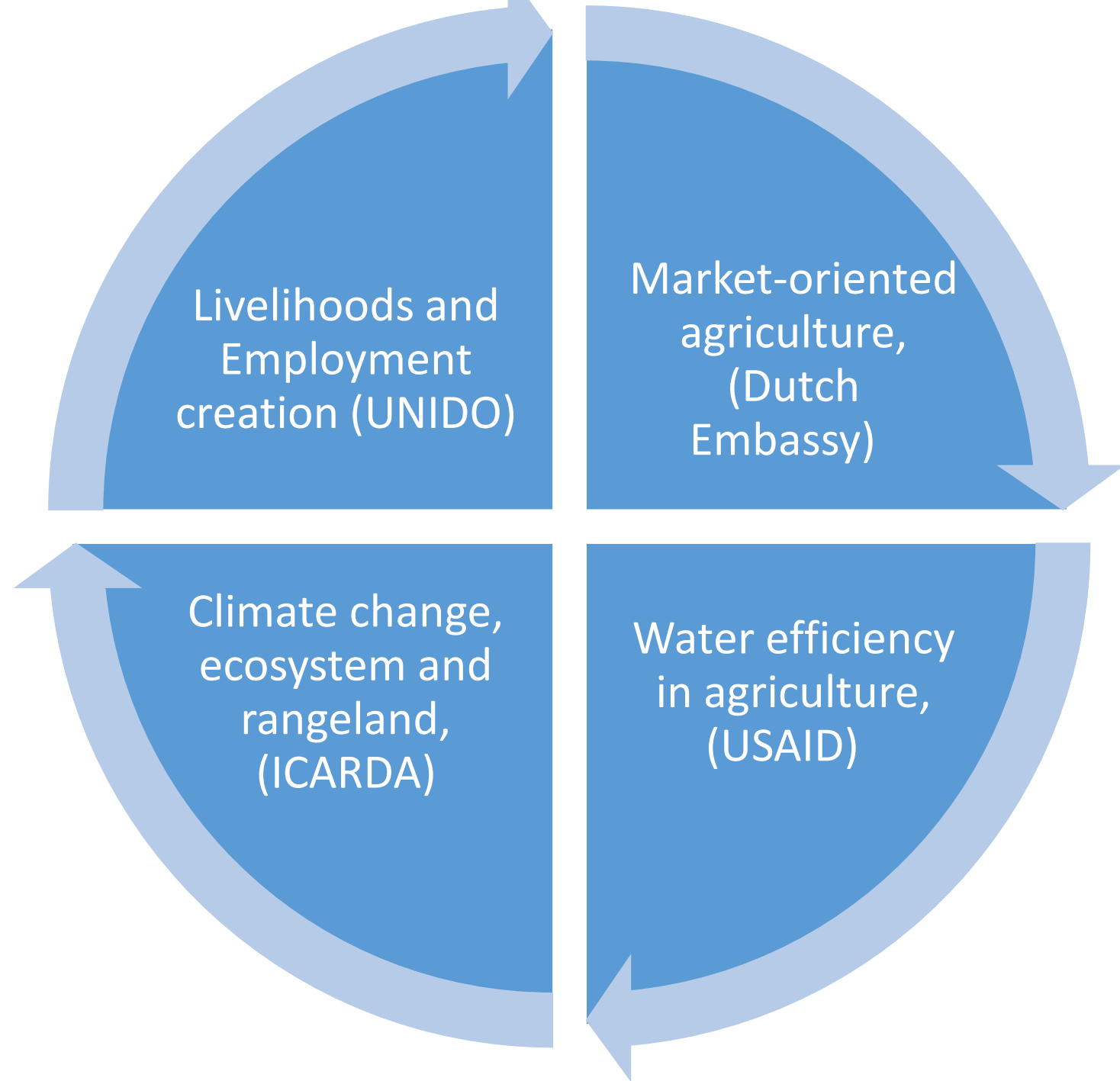

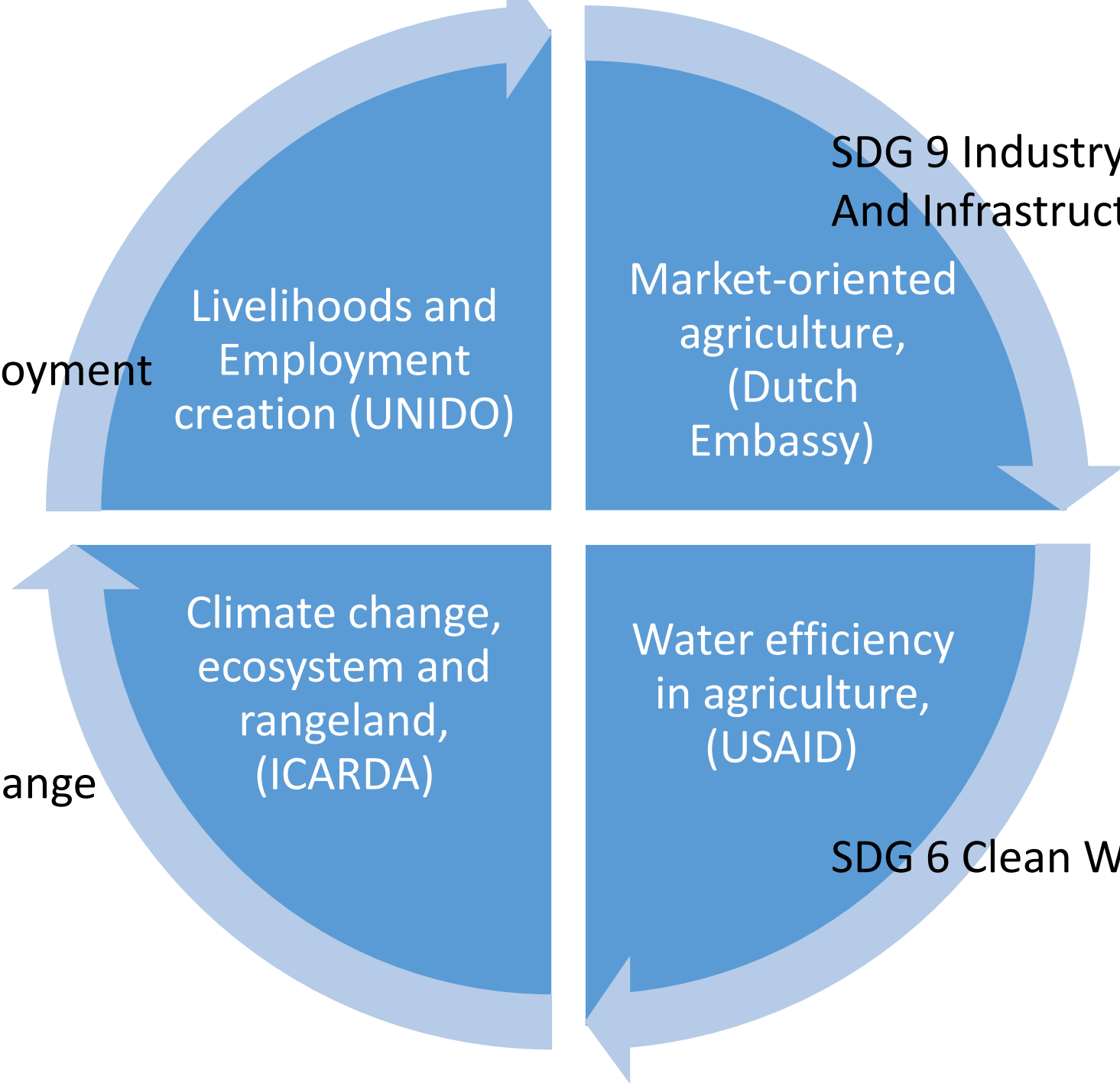

2.5.1 Number of plant and animal genetic resources for food and agriculture secured in conservation facilities
