



The Demographic Dividend - DD

DD is a potential <u>economic</u> benefit, driven by <u>demographic</u> shifts but harnessed by <u>social</u> policies

To harness Economic opportunity work in two directions simultaneously: <u>Demographic</u> + <u>Social</u>



Outcome of MDG and Forwarding SDG

Two Facts

1. Economic progress higher than social progress

2. Increased social inequality

One root cause

Lack of recognition of demographic dimension hindered intended progress


Why Demographics matters for SDGs - Empirical Egypt

Indicator	Lower fifth-p (up20p)	Upper fifth-p	% of change
Fertility Rate	3.6	2.8	-22%
% Early Marriage	40%	9%	-78%
%FGM	74%	24%	-68%

Corr(SPI, TFR)= -0.70 (Arab countries)



Arab countries by Demographic Dividend stage



- 1. More than 90% of poverty is in pre- and early-dividend
- 2. More than 85 percent of global economic activity is in the late- and post-dividend countries


