- **➡** TurkStat and Revenue Administration signed a protocol to share micro data for producing official statistics (June 2016
- ▶ Value Added Tax Declaration and Special Consumption Tax Declaration are declared monthly by establishments to Revenue Administration
- These declarations are compulsory
- → TurkStat Turnover definition can be derived from these records



Total Turnover

- (+) Delivery and Services Value (Monthly)
- (-) Sales of Depreciated Fixed Assets (Immovables, Vehicles, Fixtures, Machinery and Equipment, etc.)
- (-) Joining, Transfer, Conversion and Separation Transactions
- (-) Immovable and Affiliate Sales to Be Owned for Two Years
- (-) Special Consumption Tax



Non-Domestic Turnover

- + Exportation of goods
- + Exportation of services
- + Roaming
- + International Transportation
- + Deliveries with export record
- + Services Provided in Free Trade Zones
- + Fason Services for Customers in Free Trade Zones
- + Deliveries made by private invoice to non-residents in Turkey
- + VAT calculated sales to non-residents in Turkey (Goods with passengers)








- This comparison covers three sectors;
 - Mining and Quarrying, Manufacture, Retail Trade
- **▶** For STS Turnover Indices (re-referenced to 2011=100) published indices are used.
- For VAT indices, VAT Micro data are matched with SBR.
 Indices are computed by using activity in SBR.







- For VAT indices, VAT Micro data are matched with STS frame and STS activity.




B- Mining and Quarrying






C- Manufacturing
