












eTIR International System

The eTIR international system aims to ensure the secure exchange of data between national Customs related systems international transit of goods, vehicles or containers according to the provisions of the TIR Convention and to allow Customs to manage the data on guarantees, issued by guarantee chains to holders authorized to use the TIR system (Customs to Customs).





Invitation to interconnect to eTIR



8 April 2020, letter of ECE Executive Secretary Mrs. Olga Algayerova to all Head of Customs of TIR Convention contracting parties inviting them to start interconnection with eTIR International System.

Dear Mr. Zouaghi,

On 5 February 2020, the Administrative Committee for the TIR Convention (AC.2) adopted proposals to amend various provisions of the body of the TIR Convention, 1975 and introducing the new Amena II, which provides the legal basis for the long awaited eTIR procedure. The proposals have meanwhile been sent to the Secretary-General of the United Nations, in his capacity of depositary, and circulated to all TIR Contracting Parties.

This historical event marked the beginning of a new era, in which all stakeholders need to prepare to start implementing eTIR. As a first step, it is with great pleasure that I can inform you that the United Nations Economic Commission for Europe (UNECE) is ready to receive requests from contracting parties to connect their national customs system directly to the eTIR international system for a pilot application (Oktobes to Customs). This connection will be based on the latest varsion of the eTIR technical specifications and in coordination and connection with the relevant guarantee chain systems of the international Road Transport Union (IRCI), thus ensuring that your country is prepared to apply the eTIR procedure when Annex I leaters into force on 25 May 2021.

In case you are interested, you are invited to get in contact the TIR secretariat (stin@un.org), which stands ready to assist your administration to establish the required connection between your national customs system and the eTIR international system. 

COVID 19 Border Crossing in ESCWA region















