## ADIP - Background

#### Disability in the Arab region

- Although Arab countries are increasingly committed to realizing the rights of persons with disabilities, progress towards that end is slow.
- In the region, persons with disabilities are one of the most marginalized population groups, facing multiple barriers which hinder their ability to participate in society on an equal basis with others.
- Women with disabilities in rural areas are particularly marginalized.

#### Digital development in the Arab region

- It is worth mentioning the vital role that ICT can play for people's empowerment and in promoting better accessibility to all towards building more inclusive societies.
- In the Arab region, the ICT sector has fortunately made some positive strides in development in the past few years and, as a result, can have a great impact in digital inclusion throughout the region.

### Need to develop E-Accessibility in the Arab region (Article 9 of UN-CRPD)

- Develop national policies to identify the vision, objectives and focus areas to enable persons with disability from using technology devices in their daily life, and to ensure the surrounding environment deploys technology and innovation efficiently to ease their access.
- Develop national technical guidelines to implement e-Accessibility in public websites, e-services, procured ICT tools and devices, and in media channels and TV.

## ADIP – Guiding principles

<u>United Nations Convention on</u> <u>the Rights of Persons with</u> <u>Disabilities (UN CRPD)</u>

- The goal is to ensure that people with disabilities enjoy human rights and fundamental freedoms
- All ESCWA member States are signatories.

**UN Disability Inclusion Strategy**, (April 2018)

 Represents a UN system policy, action plan and accountability framework to strengthen systemwide accessibility and mainstreaming of the rights of persons with disabilities Beirut Consensus on Technology for Sustainable development in the Arab region (June 2018)

• ESCWA is requested to continue to provide MCs with high quality advice and specific support on technology and innovation for sustainable development, with focus on the several fields, including the inclusion of youth, older persons and persons with disabilities in areas such as education, employment and access to public services, and promoting social well-being of all.

To bridge the digital divide and enable all society members to access and use ICT.

- Arab governments and other stakeholders have developed, adopted and/or implemented policies and plans to promote E-Accessibility.
- Greater potential for an equal society is created where all is treated fair and equal despite differences, with special focus on people with specific needs and in particular persons with disabilities, which is a cross-cutting development issue in the 2030 Agenda for sustainable development.
- An effective and efficient platform that provide policy makers with the required assistance to improve inclusive and sustainable development of all.

## ADIP - Cumulative Change

#### Phase 1

- Situational analysis and assessment
- Creates key Products required for change
- Develops policy proposals and tools

#### Phase 2

- Identifies and solidifies partnerships
- Builds consensus among stakeholders
- Advocates for uptake of proposals made

#### Phase 3

- Disseminates Products and policy proposals
- Makes use of Products developed
- Provides support to implementing policies based on proposals made


