Background:



A need for high quality data on short term statistics has substantially increased after the last global financial and economic crises.

- To respond to this need three international conferences have been organized (2009 & 2011).
- A template of 12 Sets of short-term statistics with around 65 to 67 indicators has been identified.
- At regional level, ESCWA has prepared a desk study on Short-Term Economic Indicators for the Arab Region, 2013 (1)
- ESCWA acquired funds to implement a project on strengthening the capacity of national statistical systems to produce and disseminate the short term statistics.


