

COVID-19 impacted all countries around the world; but not necessarily in the same way.


Most countries around the world have announced stimulus packages targeting people and economy to mitigate the impact of the COVID-19 crisis.

Most Arab States have announced stimulus packages as well.








# COVID-19 Policy Responses Announced Stimulus (% of GDP) Across Regions of the World







#### Policy Type: Social protection policy -Total Amount of Support (% of GDP)





### **Key Observations**

- The impact of COVID-19 has negatively affected all countries and all population income groups. While policy responses need to be focused on protecting the poor and vulnerable, other mechanisms and potentially other financing approaches are needed to the support middle class. Timeliness in the response is of essence.
- The impact of the COVID-19 crisis on people, businesses, workers and families varies largely by sector, enterprise conditions and workers status, and is expected to be long lasting.
- Countries with developed social protection systems are in a better position to respond during the crisis.
   In this context, there are lessons to learn from across the world as presented in the mapping.
- Lack of adequate fiscal space is a major challenge for extending social protection, especially for middle-income countries and the LDCs; oil revenues are hit hard by the dramatic fall of oil prices, which negatively affected fiscal balance of oil-exporting countries.
- ESCWA's "Regional Emergency Response to Mitigate the Impact of COVID-19" presents specific policy suggestions, including social protection policy responses.
- ESCWA's Social Expenditure Monitor (SEM) presents a tool for improving effectiveness of social expenditures to rebalance social and economic priorities.
