WHY THE METROPOLITAN AGENDA



In February 2020, the Italian Ministry for Environment, Land and Sea Protection signed an agreement with all Metropolitan Cities for the design of their own Metropolitan Agenda 2030.

The Metropolitan City of Florence is committed to defining its own Metropolitan Agenda 2030 for Sustainable Development, in order to guide current and future strategic choices towards sustainable development, implement the National Strategy for Sustainable Development and contribute to the realization of the objectives of the Regional Strategy for Sustainable Development.

Political and programmatic tool to guide metropolitan and territorial strategic efforts already in place and align them with a vision of sustainable development


VOLUNTARY LOCAL REVIEW
