


What is a WEF nexus approach?

The WEF nexus approach provides new opportunities for :

Increasing resource efficiencies
Reducing resource scarcities
Improving human well being
Supporting political stability

By addressing the interdependencies between the respective resources (water, energy, land), human securities (water, energy, food, WEF) and sustainable development.

Implementation approach of the WEF nexus



Key basis of an iterative and continuous involvement of stakeholders from all relevant sectors:

Starting from critical (country-specific) nexus issues and inter-linkages, which serve as incentive for the different sectors to join our exercise;

>built up of a nexus knowledge base - from the evidence base, towards national and regional guidelines;

➤aiming at up-scaling and transfer of the pilot country outcomes to the LAS region.

Assisting countries to have a nexus vision:

- Evidence Base on resources and human security situation and trends in the region and in the pilot countries
- 2. Institutional and Capacity Assessment based on a review of the most important strategies, policies and institutional arrangements and on interviews with key stakeholders
- 3. Guidelines for mainstreaming of the WEF Nexus to be jointly developed with the concerned stakeholders for implementation at national and regional level
