#### BACKGROUND

- Bureau of Statistics and Census Established in 1953 by the statistical Law came out same year.
- ▶ The Statistical Law was Amended in 1963 and still in power.
- ▶ BSC Carried out Censuses (1954-1964-1973-1984-1995-2006).
- Statistical Law was Amended in 2014 but did not Approved yet.
- National Strategy for the Development of Statistics Approved by Ministry of Planning and waiting for approval by the Cabinet.

# NSDS, Legislations, Institutions and SDGs

- National Strategy for the development of Statistics was developed with assistance from PARIS21 and UNFPA and contribution from BSC, Ministries of Education, Health, Social Affairs, Agriculture, Central Bank, Academia, ...
- ▶ 7 Goals and 30 Strategies covered by 6 years (2018 2023).
- Strategy will provide data for SDGs indicators.
- ▶ The need for institutions to implement the strategy.

## NSDS, Legislations, Institutions and SDGs

- ► The 1963 Statistical Law or the updated draft in 2014 covers the legislation for the institutions in the National Statistical System.
- ► For the institutions building capacity is needed which is covered in the NSDS.
- ▶ NSDS and SDGs indicators is the responsibility of all NSS components.
- Coordination is most needed.
