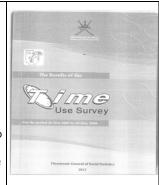

Omani Women in the Labor Market and the Challenges they Face 2011 (Arabic) The aim of this study is to highlight the reality of Omani women in the labor market and the challenges they face. So it has based on the available results from the Census 2010, and the labor force survey 2008, to highlight the aspects that have not been addressed in the census, in addition to administrative data available on employment in the public and private sectors in 2010 to review a copy of Omanis in the labor market, especially women and the challenges they face, Via two major parts. The results of the Time Use Survey

2007-2008 (Arabic- English)

This second Time Use Survey has been conducted as an accompanying survey to the Household Expenditure and Income Survey carried out during the period 20/5/2007 to 19/5/2008 on a sample representing the whole of the Sultanate and with a sample size of 2500 Omani and non-Omani families. The importance of this survey stems from the up-to-date data it provides and providing the opportunity to conduct comparisons for the purpose of measuring the extent of change between two surveys. The objectives of the survey are to identify patterns of TUS for individuals by economic and social activity, to identify the economic activity of women, to measure productivity, to determine the informal sectors size and the time spent by individuals in these sectors and finally to measure time poverty.
