



Background









The Gender Statistics Program was established at the beginning of 1996, when gender issues received greater attention in policy formulation, In program's plans both at the national and the international levels, and when the demand for statistics that adequately address these issues has increased


Objectives

- To raise awareness among policy makers, planners, NGOs, gender advocates and the public at large about the importance of gender disaggregated data for the purposes of policy formation, planning and lobbying.
- To sensitize all PCBS staff on the importance of producing gender statistics and including a gender perspective in the every – day work and ensure that gender concerns are taken into consideration in the ongoing data collection programs.


