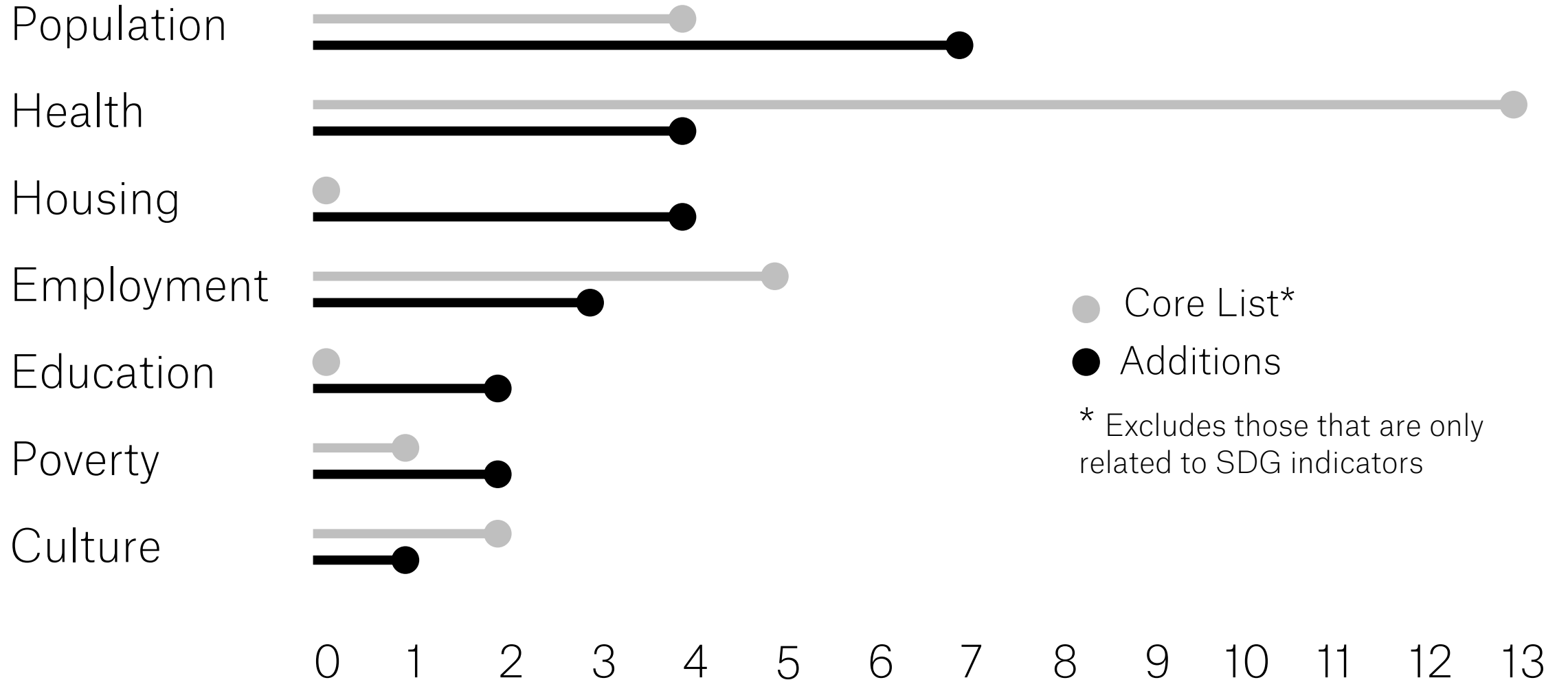


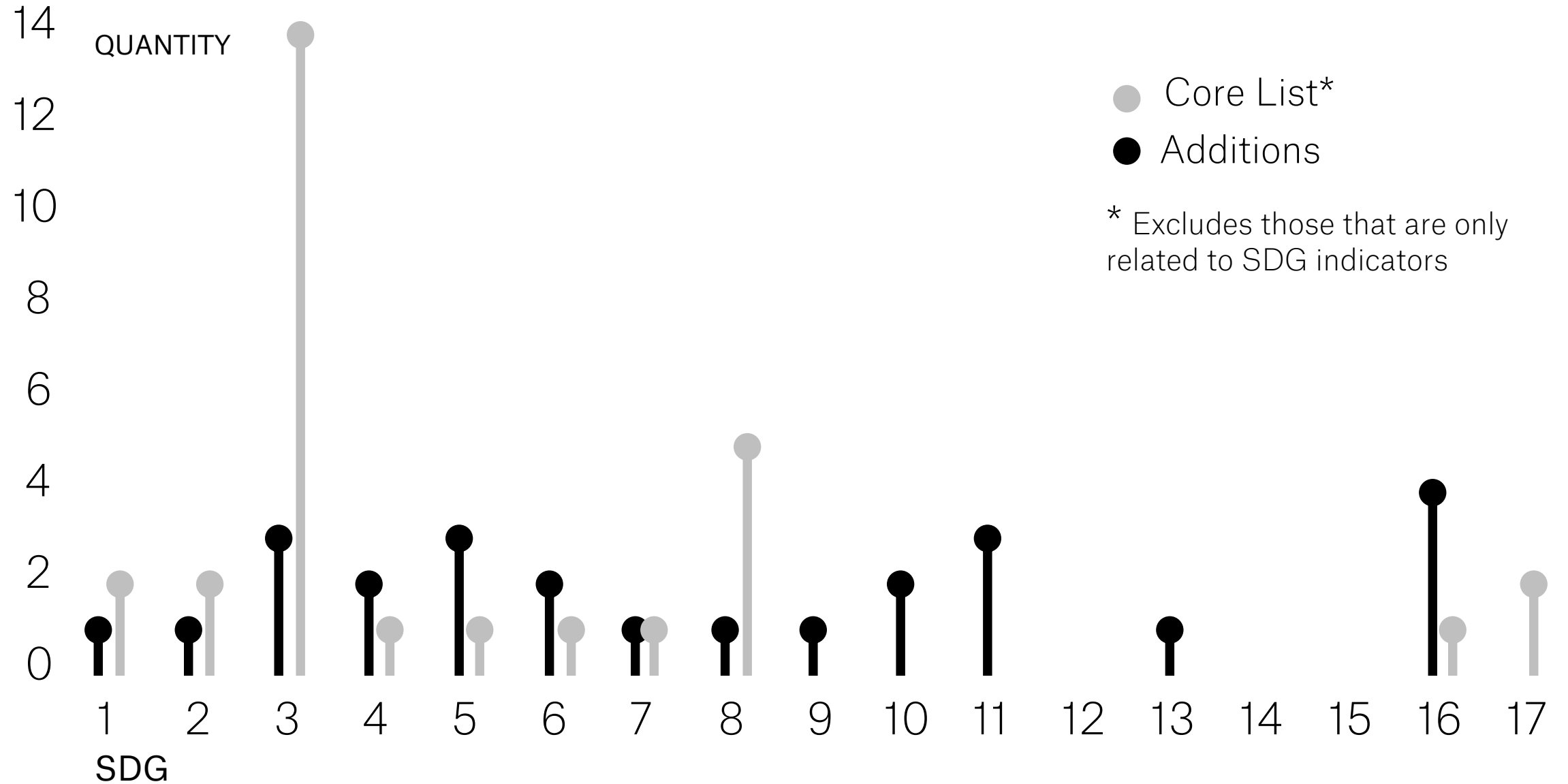

Percentage of teachers in: (a) pre-primary; (b) primary; (c) lower secondary; and (d) upper secondary education who have received at least the minimum organized teacher training (i.e. pedagogical training) pre-service or in-service required for teaching at the relevant level in a given country (Tier II)

Additions in Poverty

Growth rates of household expenditure or income per capita among the bottom 40 per cent of the population and the total population (Tier II)
