ROUND TABLE ON NATIONAL STRATEGIES FOR THE DEVELOPMENT OF STATISTICS IN SUPPORT OF THE POST-2015 DEVELOPMENT AGENDA

DISCUSSION POINTS

- 1. The Statistical Committee is invited to discuss issues related to national strategies for the development of statistics in support of the post-2015 development agenda, including the following:
- (a) Lessons learned from previous national frameworks for development indicators, such as the Millennium Development Goal indicators, positive experiences and gaps in the process;
- (b) An approach for identifying indicators to be included in national strategies for the development of statistics, including sources, methods, level of detail and periodicity;
 - (c) Necessary activities for national statistical offices;
 - (d) How to address the diverse interests and needs of member States in regional work;
- (e) How to reconcile the diverse needs of member States with the need for harmonized indicators at the regional and global levels;
 - (f) How to benefit from the experiences of leading statistical offices in the region and worldwide.
- 2. The Statistical Committee may wish to make recommendations on related actions to be implemented by the Economic and Social Council for Western Asia (ESCWA) and other regional and international partners.
